TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Payment of Fees

Payment of fees is required before your child will be placed in a team. The fee payable will be based on the players age as at 30 April of the year in which this season finishes. For the 2009/2010 season this means the age is calculated by the **players age on 30th April 2010**.

No Refunds

The Club operates under a No Refunds policy. All fees paid are utilised for the development and administration of the Club.

Team Placements

Team selections will be by way of a "Draft". The coaches of each team will select one player each until all players have been selected. The number of teams will be determined by the number of players in each grade. Requests for players to play in a particular team may or may not necessarily be considered.

Club Uniforms and Equipment

The collection of Club uniforms and equipment at the close of the season is a time consuming and potentially expensive exercise. The cost of replacing uniforms and/or equipment given to you during the season will be passed on to you in the event that those uniforms and/or equipment are not returned by the end of the season.
